The Conseil québécois du loisir (Ouebec Leisure Council), which will be hosting the World Leisure Congress, and its many partners, are happy to welcome this unprecedented event under World Leisure's stewardship. The World Leisure Congress Quebec 2008 will take place from October 6th to 10th at the Centre des congrès de Québec (Quebec Congress Centre), recently cited as the best congress centre in the world and located in the heart of Quebec City, which will be celebrating its 400th anniversary in 2008.

After 20 years of absence, the World Leisure Congress returns to North America. It sets out to create a favourable place for encounters and discussions amongst decision makers, researchers, practitioners, students and volunteers from all over the world. Over 1.200 stakeholders from 40 different countries are expected at this international event. A first for Quebec!

The second goal the organising committee members have set out to achieve is to create an "opening to the world" for all Quebec and Canadian stakeholders and also to promote an "opening to our world" by presenting the successes, the initiatives and the drive of Quebeckers in the field of leisure.

A CONTEMPORARY THEME

The congress' main theme is: "How do communities convert leisure for their development?". The following three sub-themes also give food for thought:

- Leisure: Plurality, identity, solidarity
- Leisure: Public and private space
- Leisure: Prevention, health, well-being

This very current theme questions the manner in which communities integrate, use and configure leisure to their social, cultural and economic environment. Communities are considered here in the broad sense of the word; i.e. people linked by interests, a history and an organisation with which they identify, within which they participate and for which they show solidarity. Leisure is addressed according to the four dimensions which give it meaning: time, activities, state of mind and the experience it provides.

AN ECO-RESPONSIBLE EVENT

The World Leisure Congress organising committee adheres to the eco-responsibility values. It aims at integrating the environmental, social and economic dimensions to the whole of the activities with sustainable development in mind.

This event is a pilot project in connection with the development of a Quebec certification in eco-responsible practices. This certification will be produced by

the Réseau québécois des femmes en environnement (Quebec women's network for environment) in cooperation with the Quebec Standards Bureau.

A REMARKABLE PROGRAM SCHEDULE

Every day, the Congress will begin with a big conference, followed by a panel. The afternoon will be engaged in workshops, presentations in various formats such as presentation of the results of scientific research, study cases, round tables, workshops, training sessions, and also in-kiosk presentations. Furthermore, partners from the various fields will be called upon to animate the event and therefore demonstrate to all participants the motivation behind Quebec's stakeholders in the field of leisure. Several social and protocolar activities, as well as an important commercial exhibition fair are also on the program schedule.

PACKAGES TAILORED TO YOUR NEEDS

Most of these are located a short distance away from the Centre des congrès (congress centre) and in the historical heart of the city, which is, incidentally, on UNESCO's prestigious world heritage list. The proximity of the hotels allows delegates to get around easily, by foot, from their rooms to the activity sites, without having to worry about their vehicles or parking spaces!

It is possible to take a virtual tour of the various hotels via the Congress' web site. You will thus be able to make your room reservations in the hotel that meets your specific needs. Another efficient way to plan your stay in Quebec in 2008!
